The scholarships are intended to recognise the real value of Membership and to ensure the sharing of best practice and latest developments within our profession; two ideals to which Crown is totally committed.

One Crown scholarship will be awarded to an Australian conference attendee and one to a New Zealand attendee.

The scholarships will cover full registration for current Members of ARANZ or ASA, or membership of the appropriate society for 2005/6 and full conference registration for anyone not yet a member but keen to become one.

The scholarships are intended for someone who would not normally be able to attend the conference. Applicants must:

- provide a statement themselves, or one from their manager, giving evidence of the fact that they would not normally be able to attend.
- not be in receipt of any other financial support to attend the conference, whether from an employer or external source.
- provide a statement of why they wish to attend the conference (up to half a page)
- be able to attend the entire conference and the AGM of the Society to which they belong (or would seek to belong to).
